Student requirements for participating in the online courses:

The courses will be conducted via video and audio via "Zoom". Live "Zoom" conferences allow the instructor to view and talk with students. Once a course is scheduled and a student is registered, a link will be provided for the students to join the conference.

At the beginning of the course, all students must provide Proof of Identity in one of the following forms:

- State-issued Drivers' License or
- Non-Driver's License or
- Passport

This process allows the online instructor to verify the correct person is online during the classroom session. A scanned color copy of the student's ID must be emailed to msiu@qfpcinc.com

Each online classroom training session will not exceed a maximum of 4 hours in length per scheduled online classroom session.

Attendance will be taken at the beginning of class during the online classroom session after students have returned from breaks, and at the end of the session. This attendance will be confirmed by verifying the The student is online and his/her camera is active.

All students must be visible at all times while the course is taking place and the student's camera must remain active the entire time the class is in session.

The student may turn off the camera during a break until the class resumes. Any student who leaves the camera view without permission at any time will be marked absent from the class.

Quality Training Institute will retain all the attendance records for auditors of FDNY at any time.

Quality Training Institute will provide the students with all required handouts and other required classroom material for review before the scheduled online class session. All material will be distributed to the student via the student's email address provided. All students are encouraged to read the material before the class.

The FLSD course must be paid for before the material is electronically sent.

Courses which consist of group discussions will be able to be conducted during the online session.

Courses that consist of practical skills exercises or hand on demonstrations will be conducted during the online session via the instructor's camera.

The instructor-to-student will not exceed twenty (25) students per class.

The graduation test will be also conducted online \underline{OR} in person under the supervision of a proctor or instructor.

For the graduation test, we will provide the FDNY-supplied test only. Students shall not use outside materials when taking the test.

Students will be required to have a computer or Laptop with a camera.

The graduation tests will be scheduled after the completion of the class.

Course Information for the F89/T89:

The Fire and Life Safety Director (FLSD) course will be comprised of building systems and fire components (20 hours total), and non-fire emergencies with an active shooter and medical emergencies component (11 hours total). The course can be adjusted as needed if students need to complete one of the two components.
